



## TRAVEL INFORMATION FOR YOUR SON/DAUGHTER IF DUE TO START SIXTH FORM AT SACKVILLE SCHOOL IN SEPTEMBER 2016

### **For students living in the West Sussex area**

- 3in1 Green Card (bus) – This card costs £50.00 (exempt from payment under certain criteria's – see website) and allows 16-19 year olds to receive a 50% discount on adult fares, along with proof of age and many other benefits/discounts (see website for information).
- Sussex Student Card (rail) – This card is free and allows 16-18 year olds to receive a 34% discount on train season tickets in Sussex.

Both forms are available on [www.westsussex.gov.uk](http://www.westsussex.gov.uk) under the education section or alternatively collect a form from Mrs Underdown, KS5 Student Support Assistant. Once the form is complete please return to Mrs Underdown with a passport photo. This will then be counter-signed and posted by the school.

### **For students living in the East Sussex area**

- 3i-D travel card – This card is free and qualifies 16-19 year olds for reduced bus fares as well as acting as a proof of age card. The 3i-D card will allow you to purchase the weekly East Sussex Freedom ticket for £16.00 from the bus driver. The Freedom Ticket gives the student unlimited travel on nearly every bus in East Sussex for seven days in a row, including weekends.

### **For students living in the Surrey area**

- Bus and Train Student Fare Cards – This card costs £25.00 and will qualify 16-18 year olds to travel on Surrey buses for the under 16s fare. You can only apply for this application online by visiting [www.surreycc.gov.uk](http://www.surreycc.gov.uk) under the school transport section.

### **For students living in the Kent area**

- 16+ Travel Card – Applications can be made directly by students to KCC Public Transport online at: [www.kent.gov.uk/post16travel](http://www.kent.gov.uk/post16travel) or you can apply directly by post sending an application form to: Kent 16+ Travel Card, Kent County Council, Public Transport, PO Box 441, Aylesford, Kent, ME6 9HJ. The standard full year cost of a pass is £400.00.

A student with a household income of less than £16,191 will be entitled to receive the sixth form bursary at the discretion of the school to cover the cost of the card. Please note travel passes will only be released at the start of the academic year and with confirmation that the bursary has been awarded. The application process can take a maximum of 4 weeks therefore please apply by 15<sup>th</sup> July in order to receive the travel pass for the start of the academic year. **Where a travel pass is not received by the start of the term, the student must make arrangements to pay for their travel until the pass is received.**
