

Marcus Alexander's Books:

Crow's Revenge (Keeper of the Realms #1):

Forced to flee her home in the gloomy, rain-drenched landscape of London by a bloodthirsty and terrifying new foe, Charlie Keeper escapes to the vibrant, parallel land of Bellania with nothing more than her common sense and razor-sharp wits to keep her safe. Bellania, a land of myth, magic and marauding giants with bad attitude and poor anger management.

The Dark Army (Keeper of the Realms #2):
