## Ski Trip Killington 2021 Kit List

We will travel for approximately 7 hours by plane and then 2 -3 hours by coach to our resort after leaving Heathrow. It is important therefore that you dress accordingly. Clothing should be as comfortable as possible. You should have appropriate footwear and a jacket for when we transfer from the plane to the coach.

### Ski Clothing

Ski socks (2)	Goggles/ski sunglasses (UV rated)
Thin socks (2)	Fleece
Ski pants/Salopette	Sweatshirt (2)
Tights/long pants/shorts/thermals	T-shirt/vest/thermals
Ski jacket (warm & waterproof)	Face protection cream (sun cream)
Ski gloves / mitts (2)	Lip protection cream
Ski hat	Face ski mask

### Other Clothing

Boots/shoes	Underwear
Trainers	Sweatshirt
Scarf/neck tube	Shirts/blouses
Socks	Warm nightwear
Trousers/skirt	

The above are clothes that will be worn when pupils are not skiing. They need to be suitable for a warm, centrally heated hotel and also for cold evening outings in the town. It would seem sensible to take spares of several of items on the list.

### Other Items

Washing kit (soap, flannel, toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, conditioner etc)	Books/games (for evenings, other spare time and plane/coach journey)
Torch app on mobile phone	Purse/wallet
Tissues	Foreign currency (American dollars)
Ball point pens, pencils, paper, notebook	English money for use at the airport

### Although not essential the following may also come in useful:

Medical items (e.g. throat sweets)  
Chocolate/biscuits/sweets  
Plastic bags  
Camera  
Mobile phone, charger and continental adapter for the USA

There are limits to the luggage capacity allowed by of 20kgs. If a student goes over this weight limit then they are liable for the extra costs occurred and not the school.
